Welcoming Everyone Following Jesus Sharing Life

This is our new mission statement, summing up what St. Alban's is all about.

The church council spent a lot of time discussing vision and how to communicate our values. We felt that it should start with 'welcoming everyone' because St. Alban's is here for everybody. Whoever you are, whatever your background, wherever you are from, however you feel about faith. you are welcome.

We then looked at the Bible and felt that 'following Jesus' should be next, because Jesus often said to people 'follow me'. He didn't just tell people about God or how to live their lives, he invited them into an exciting relationship.



Finally, we want to be 'sharing life'. This has two meanings. We want to be a family, sharing joys a n d sorrows together. We also want to share the news about good Jesus, who said that he was 'the life'. He taught that only he could bring 'life in all its fullness' and can offer us 'eternal life'. This is something we can't possibly keep to ourselves!

The Way Ahead

Our focus for the next year will be on three main areas. We will be developing the prayer life of the church, because this underpins who we are and what we do. We will be running an Alpha Course (see inside).

And we hope to improve our facilities for the whole community by building a link between the church and hall. This will provide more space and improve access to toilets etc. Look out for ways to get involved!



In John 10:10 Jesus said he came to bring 'life in all its fullness'. So at 10:10 each day (am or pm) please pray for our vision and for the year ahead. Simply ask God to help us be a church which is 'welcoming, following and sharing'.

Welcome to our new Curate!


On Sunday 2nd July, Derek Holbird was ordained at Guildford Cathedral. The sun shone as nine men and women were ordained as deacons. A further seven were ordained in the afternoon.

The legal Oath of Allegiance was taken before the service. Following the procession and the welcome, the candidates were presented to Bishop Andrew. Before the sermon we had the readings, with the Old Testament being read by Paul Livingstone from our parish. Then each candidate was ordained by the Bishop who placed his hands upon their

heads. A Bible was given to all of them and they were welcomed by the packed congregation. After the Communion, the Bishop led the newly ordained curates, with their friends and families through the cathedral. It is hoped that they will be ordained as priests in a year's time.

Derek is a 'self supporting minister' (SSM) and will be in the parish most Sundays and on some days during the week.
